Have fun thinking of ways to interpret this in your own way.

- You may submit two pieces, each no larger than 20 X 24,” and we will guarantee at least one is included in the exhibit.
- You may submit broadsides or books.
- You are welcome to submit older pieces that fit the theme.
- All framed pieces need D-rings/wire hanging on back
- Delivery at the Collins Gallery is on Friday, November 1, 2019 from 10-12 and is the responsibility of the artist as is pick up at the Collins Gallery on Sunday, January 5 from 10-12. If you are unable to come, please have someone else deliver or pick up your work during these times.
- Your work will not be insured by the Multnomah County Library.
- This is an exhibition only, work may not be for sale.

Exhibit Entry/Information:

- If you want your work considered for publicity (the library will be designing and printing postcards and flyers, and will include information on their website), application and photo must be submitted by August 1, 2019.
- Download entry forms for each piece and either mail via USPS or email to JoAnn Pari-Mueller.
- Send your photo(s) to Ellen White (ellen@kittycentral.us). Photos need to be at least 300 dpi and must be of the piece only, no mats or frames included. Make sure to take the photo straight on with no glass glare. Identify photo with last name, first name, and title.
- If you do not want to have your work considered for publicity, the final due date for submission of the entry form(s) and photo(s) is September 15, 2019.
