Guidelines/Information:

- You may submit two pieces, each no larger than 20 X 24,” and we will guarantee at least one is included in the exhibit.
- You may submit broadsides or books.
- You are welcome to submit older pieces that fit the theme.
- All framed pieces need D-rings/wire hanging on back

- Delivery and pick up are the responsibility of the artist. If you are unable to come, please have someone else deliver or pick up your work during these times.
 - Delivery at the Collins Gallery is on Friday, November 1, 2019 from 10-12.
 - Pick up at the Collins Gallery is on Sunday, January 5, 2020, from 10-12.

- Your work will not be insured by the Multnomah County Library.
- This is an exhibition only, work may not be for sale. You may have business cards on display.

Exhibit Entry/Information:

- To commemorate this special 50-year anniversary show, we will be printing booklets that will have images of the artwork in the show. For this reason, we are asking for photos and a brief description of your pieces.

Deadline to Enter: September 15, 2019

Optional publicity opportunity deadline: August 5, 2019

- The library will be designing and printing postcards and flyers, and will include information on their website. If you would like your work to be considered for publicity, submit your application to JoAnn and a photo to Ellen no later than August 5, 2019.

Image Requirements

- Photos need to be at least 300 dpi and must be of the piece only, no mats or frames included.
- Make sure to take the photo straight on with no glass glare.
- Identify photo with last name, first name, and title.
