Folded Pen

Bring any that you already own. The pens made from Coke cans from classes with Brody Neuenschwander and/or Peter Thornton will not work well for us in this workshop. Folded Pens that I recommend (pictured in the order listed here). Please have at least one folded pen that you enjoy working with.

Tim's Pen – Radius or Mini Radius – John Neal Books

Luthis Libelula – John Neal Books

Horizon Brass Folded Pen – Paper & Ink Arts (available as a nib or a in a holder)

Radius-Cut Pilot Parallel Pen, 6 mm or 3.8 mm – John Neal Books



Ink – Higgins Eternal or Walnut.

Optional: bring a bottle or two of colored inks that you like to use. It is much simpler to dip our folded pens into ink than to fuss with the watercolor pans in the paintbox.

Paper – Gilbert Bond (11"x17") is my favorite paper for any calligraphy practice. We can find it locally in Portland at Columbia as well as the Bookstores at PCC.

Pencil, cotton rag, water container

Bring along some words you want to work with. These letters have a sincere, yet quirky quality. Find some texts that you feel can be expressed with Ben Shahn Letters.

I will have for sale a new (to me anyway) Mitchell nib that uniquely works well for writing Ben Shahn Letters very small. Bring \$2 if you are interested in a nib, and a handle if you want to try it in class.
