PROSPECTUS

- This exhibit will feature members' calligraphy that explores the beauty of writing and design, and empowers calligraphers to write words that are personally meaningful.
- Members may submit two works. There is no size limitation.
- Sorry, no three dimensional artworks are able to be displayed in the Chapel Gallery. (Or mount your book in a shadow box that can be hung).
- Art must be framed or mounted and ready to hang.
- In celebration of the theme of reconnection, you may submit works that were exhibited previously in any of our PSC online exhibits. In addition, you may submit works that have not been previously exhibited in an in-person PSC exhibit. New work is encouraged, as well. Artists who exhibited in the Beautiful Worlds online exhibit may exhibit other work or enter the previous piece/s.
- If you use words other than your own, please make sure that those words are in the public domain and not copyrighted. Generally, works older than 100 years are in the public domain, but there are exceptions. To make sure a work is in the public domain, type into a word search engine (such as Google): "Are the words of _____ in the public domain?" If the work is still copyrighted, you can contact the copyright holder for permission.

- Remember to always give credit on your artwork to the author.
